

Other Bailout Kit Suggestions

- Fishing Vest or Zippered pants, (instead of Smak-Pak)
- Small USB Battery Pack
- Jacket
- Miniature held aviation transceiver (Yaesu FTA-250L)
- Multi-tool knife (Leatherman or SOG)
- Food
 - Energy Bars
 - Tootsie Rolls
- Water
 - Sealed emergency pouches
 - Water purifying straw
- Flashlight (LED)
- Medicine (OTC and/or prescribed)
- Static line on parachute
- Parachute components (canopy, shrouds)

One Last Important Thought

Each time that you land use the following steps to enhance your Parachute Muscle Memory

- 1) Once you have landed keep your parachute on as you exit the glider
- 2) Look down at your parachute's ripcord handle
- 3) Grasp the handle and simulate pulling it



Repeating these steps each time that you fly will enhance your chances of making a successful bailout!
